27 new Advocates were added to the CASA team for a total of 79 Advocates. The Advocates served 393 of the 764 children in foster care (serving 51.4%). 113 children received permanency as their cases closed. Advocates gave 10,264 of their time, energy and support for Douglas County's most vulnerable citizen ~ the child in foster care. The value of their time equaled \$255,163. They spent 2,014 hours in training learning how to advocate more effectively for these children., and they traveled 58,927 miles in service for these children.
