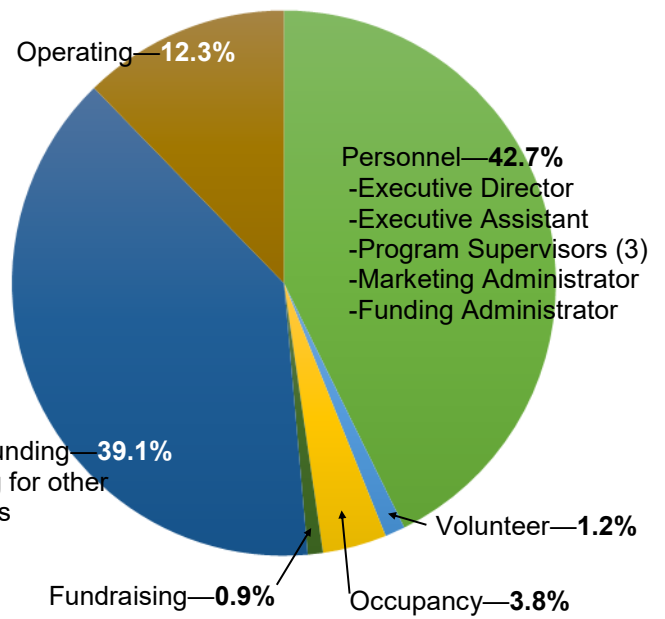
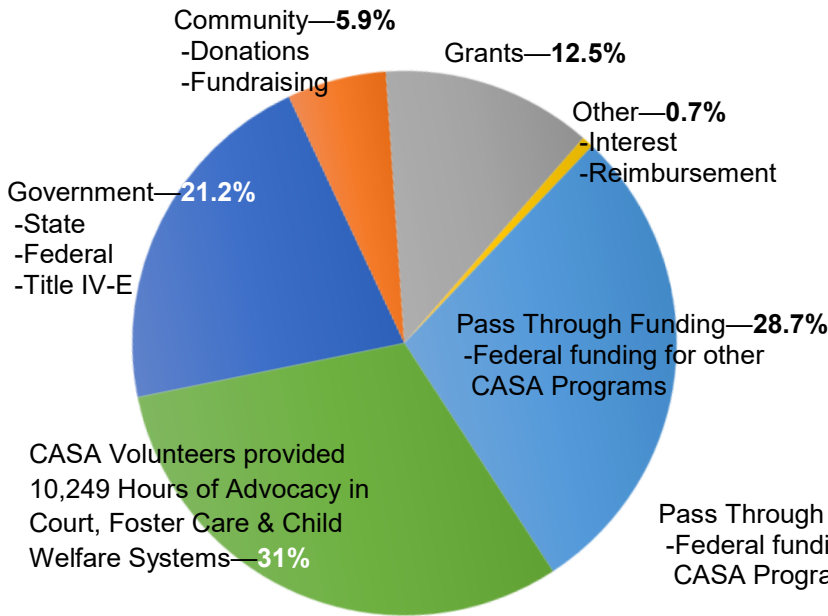

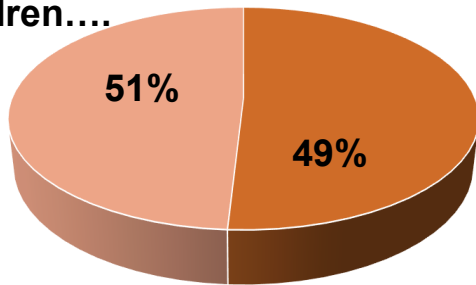

CASA of Douglas County Volunteers served 398 children....

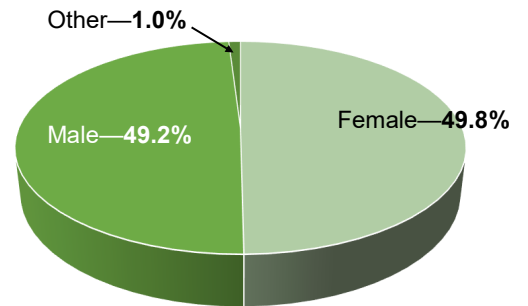


Services 95 CASA Advocates provided to the 398 children:

- Miles traveled—68,931

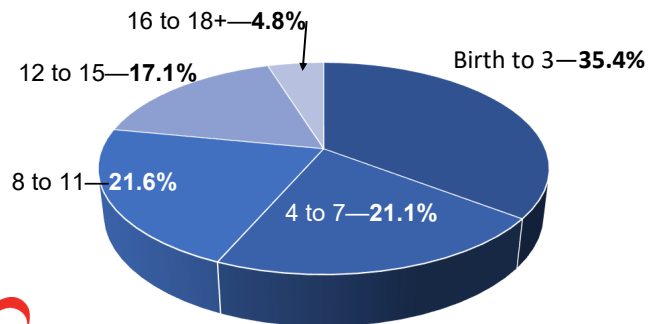
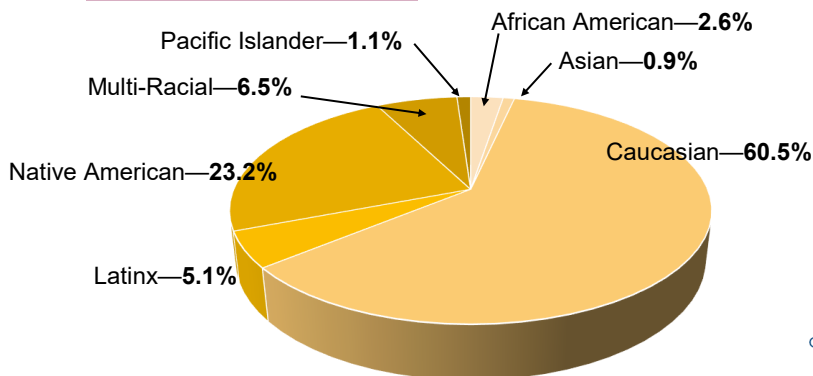
